

BITUCOAT BF-Tape

Properties:

BITUCOAT BF-Tape is a malleable, temperature-resistant bitumen strip that is used for strengthening construction and movements joints (loop forming).

BITUCOAT BF-Tape adheres strongly to all BITUCOAT products and is to a large extent resistant to diluted acids and bases.

BITUCOAT BF-Tape must not be allowed to interact with solvents, such as those present in some solvent-containing bitumen products, as this would lessen its adhesive properties.

Processing:

All subsurfaces must be solid and stable, clean and free of oil or grease as well as free of flaws, gaping cracks and flashes. *BITUCOAT* ground must be applied to the respective area as an adhesive agent.

The appropriate *BITUCOAT* thick layer is applied to both sides of the joint where surfaces have been prepared as explained above, and the *BITUCOAT BF-Tape* is then put into this. Whereby the edges of the strip must be embedded in the film.

The *BITUCOAT BF-Tape* can be laid smoothly over joints that move only slightly. In the case of movement joints, the strip must be laid in loops, whereby a round cord, e.g. out of closed cellular foam or SBR, must be inserted into the joint.

Please note that all joints sealed with *BITUCOAT BF-Tape* must be protected against any mechanical damage.
